The Publisher regrets that an error appeared in Table 5 of this article. The numbers and percentages for acute postpartum admission to $\frac{\text{HDU/ICU}}{\text{theatre "Yes"}}$ occurrence were incorrectly stated as PMU n = 85 (7.8%), TMH n = 371 (13.0%).

They have been corrected to PMU n = 9(0.8%), TMH n = 126(4.1%), as per the following table.
